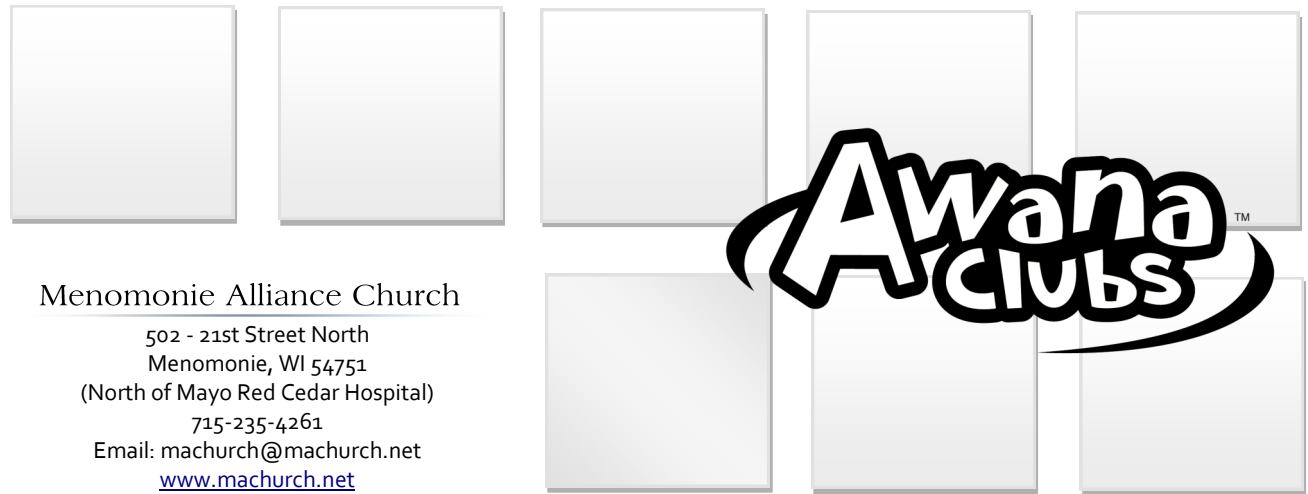

▶ What is Awana?

AWANA is a Bible focused program for children up to 5th grade that emphasizes Scripture memorization in a healthy, encouraging atmosphere. Our goal is to help children increasingly know and love God.

WHEN AND WHERE WE MEET

Cubbies

Cubbies is designed for children 2 years prior to Kindergarten. Bible-centered handbooks and club activities help your child to build a basic understanding of Christianity at an early age while having a fun evening. Children must be able to use the restroom independently to start the Cubbies Program.



Sparks

Sparks is designed for Kindergarten through second grade students. The aim of the curriculum is to take youngsters a step deeper into God's Word through Bible teaching, Scripture memorization, and life application. Children must be 5 years of age and entering Kindergarten to start the Sparks program.



TnT

The name Truth & Training reflects the passion of AWANA to teach 3rd – 5th grade children the truth of God's Word and train them to follow Christ in their daily lives. The T&T clubs focus on living out the truths of Scripture in everyday life, and being a witness for Christ amongst one's peers. Children must be 8 years old and entering the 3rd grade to start T&T.

WE NEED YOUR HELP!

Parents are an essential part of a child's AWANA experience. Your involvement is necessary for maximum growth and learning. Please use the following as a guideline for AWANA:

- Encourage your child verbally and by showing excitement for their spiritual growth in knowledge and action.
- Be consistent in club attendance. This allows for continuity in Bible lessons and helps your clubber form strong relationships with peers.
- Make sure your child brings their book and Bible each week, and wears their uniform.
- Help your child accomplish at least 1-2 handbook sections each week. A steady pace throughout the year will allow them to finish their book by May.
- In consideration of the club leaders, please pick up your child promptly.
